

**WHITE SANDS PRIMARY SCHOOL
POLICY TO SUBSIDISE PUPILS UNDER THE NEU PC PLUS PROGRAMME**

The NEU PC Plus Programme offers less-privilege student/disabled people a brand new computer bundled with free broadband and software at an affordable price. It aims to help low-income families enjoy an e-enabled life at less than \$300.

To apply for the NEU PC Plus Programme, one must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Singapore Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Be a full time student in Government/Government-Aided School, Junior College, Centralized Institute, Independent School, ITE, Polytechnic or MOE-registered Special Education School.
- Gross household income not exceeding \$2000 per month or per capita monthly income of your household is no more than \$500 (or no more than \$700 if a household member is a person with disability)
- Each eligible household can apply for one computer only regardless of total number of school-going children and/or household members who are persons with disability.
- Household should not have a working PC
- If you have obtained a new PC under the NEU PC Programme (Type A, B, E and F), it must be at least 5 years ago

In line with the school's Strategic Thrust of a Pervasive ICT Culture, we will work towards a 100% PC ownership and internet availability from home for all pupils. The school offers further subsidy to successful applicants based on the following:

Exception: Pupils who are given further subsidy by the Lead Agencies (CDAC, AMP, SINDA etc.) will not qualify under the subsidy stated above.
